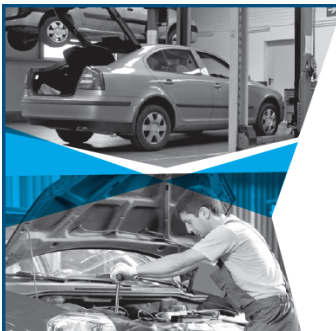

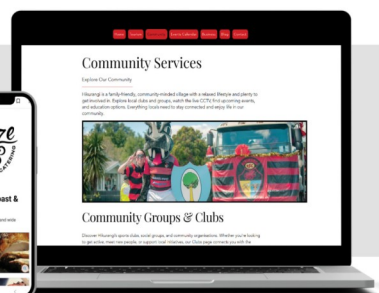
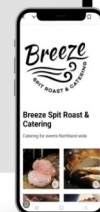

## HIKURANGI HISTORICAL MUSEUM



The Hikurangi Museum was closed for visitors in January, but our volunteers were not having a break. They worked hard to clean and renovate the old Council Building, as well as rearranging some of our displays and doing important collection management work. It looks fabulous! We moved a big three-dimensional map of the Hikurangi Catchment to the old Council Building so it is now in context with displays on other early industries of Hikurangi. This map was created in the 1970s by Colin Anderson, a field-assistant for the Northland Catchment Commission. The map shows the Hikurangi Swamp and the Hikurangi Flood Major Scheme, which was established in the 1970s following years of flooding and drainage works to turn the wetlands into pasture. This artefact is an excellent starting point for visitors to understand where Hikurangi is situated and what the specific geological features of our area are.

Please visit us to see what we have achieved. If you have visited before, come again - it really looks quite different!

**HIKURANGI VOLUNTEER FIRE BRIGADE**

Volunteer firefighters have begun training for the 2026 year, continuing their commitment to protect and serve the community. These dedicated volunteers balance full-time jobs, family responsibilities, and personal commitments while remaining ready to respond to emergencies at any hour.

Training sessions started earlier this month and will continue throughout 2026. Firefighters participate in hands-on drills, classroom instruction, and practical scenarios designed to prepare them for a wide range of incidents. From structure fires and vehicle accidents to medical emergencies, ongoing training ensures firefighters stay current with equipment, techniques, and safety procedures.

Safety remains a top priority not only for firefighters, but also for the public. The brigade is reminding residents of the importance of safely traveling around emergency scenes. Many incidents occur along roadways, where distracted or rushed driving can create dangerous conditions. Motorists are urged to slow down, remain alert, and follow instructions from emergency personnel when approaching an incident. Drivers should obey move-over laws by changing lanes or reducing speed when emergency vehicles are present with lights activated. Giving firefighters space to work helps prevent additional accidents and keeps everyone involved safer. Emergency scenes can change quickly, and what may appear calm can still present serious hazards.

Volunteer firefighters continue to answer the call whenever needed. In January we responded to 17 calls for service. These calls included a variety of emergencies requiring quick response and teamwork.

**Tēnā koutou katoa,**

Around this time two years ago we were battling Cyclone Gabrielle. Once again, mother nature has hit parts of the motu hard, and some communities are facing massive clean-ups. Russell Road is likely to be closed for months. When it will reopen – or when work will officially begin – is still anyone's guess.

As we all get back into the grind of mahi, tamariki, kura and the costs that come with starting a new year, we know this can be a real struggle for some whānau. If anyone is finding things tough, please reach out. We don't have much, but we can offer support and connect you with partner agencies who can help.

**Heads up:** Smiley and I will soon be running traffic checkpoints with support from the Whangārei Traffic Unit. These will target alcohol and drug driving, as well as driver licence breaches. Don't be surprised if you come through one of these checkpoints.

A big thank-you to the team who painted over the graffiti on the Guyco building and surrounding areas. Your mahi is appreciated.

**Issues within Hikurangi township:**

Boy racers, car-enthusiast groups, and dirt-bike riders continue to be an ongoing issue and, at times, feel like a losing battle for Police. It appears the intersection of **Marua Road and Otonga-Marua Road** is once again being used frequently for this behaviour.

We encourage residents living nearby to stay alert but avoid approaching or confronting any groups involved. If you witness activity, please report it as soon as it is safe to do so. Useful information includes vehicle descriptions, registration numbers, and times/locations — but only if you can obtain these details safely.

Reminder as it is still very warm out there. Kei te whiti te rā/The sun is shining, Ka wera ngā rā/The days are hot, so Slip Slop and Slap on a pōtae/hat. That's all from me this month. Kia tūpato – stay safe, take care, and look after each other. If there is an *immediate* risk, call **111**. For non-urgent matters, contact Police on **105**, or speak directly with Smiley or me. **Victim Support** is also available and offers confidential assistance.
