HIKURANGI HISTORICAL MUSEUM



At Hikurangi Museum, we recently held another successful Anzac Day. Whānau and friends came together to remember their loved ones by writing dedications on beautiful red poppies. It was a

special opportunity to reflect, share, and honour those who served.

We are committed to acknowledging all those from our community who served Aotearoa. We recognise that the stories of many soldiers from the 28th Māori Battalion are not yet fully represented within our museum space. The story of George Manapiri Pitman, from Whakapara, was recently shared by his whānau through RNZ.

It reminds us of the strength, sacrifice, and resilience of these men and their families. His journey - as a soldier, sportsman, prisoner of war, and devoted father - reflects the experiences of many whose contributions have not always been recognised.

Importantly, it also highlights the reality many Māori soldiers faced upon returning home.

Despite their service and sacrifice, many received little acknowledgement or support.

Some, like Pitman and his fellow soldiers, returned home to no formal welcome and received nothing for their efforts. These experiences are an important part of our shared history that must be told.

We believe these stories are taonga - a treasure.

Hikurangi Museum is working towards ensuring our military displays better reflect all who served from our rohe, including those from the 28th Māori Battalion.

We warmly invite local whānau to share their stories, memories, and connections, so together we can honour and preserve the legacy of our people for future generations.

Ka maumahara tonu tātou ki a rātou - we will remember them.

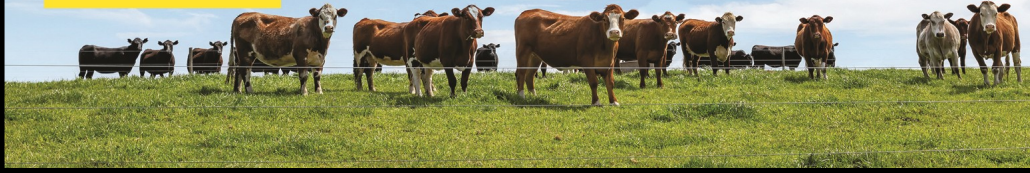

Hikurangi Police Tēnā koutou katoa,

This bulletin topics relate to what's happened in between our last bulletin. Every now and then I will touch on "what's happening in the news now". Crime wise I like to focus on what is happening in and around Hikurangi.

Anzac Service - Good turnout for the Anzac service last month. Great to see everyone coming together to remember those that had served and lost their lives and those that are still serving.

Duck Shooting - season opened last weekend. Be aware that Police, Fish and Game Rangers will be making their way farm/maimai's to ensure everyone was being safe around firearm safety and proper hunting practices. There focus will be on unlawful hunting practices (shooting without a licence, use of lead shot and excess bag limits).

The Fish and Game Rangers will continue to stay visible over the rest of the season.

Burglaries - as times are getting hard because of what's happening overseas there have been a series of thefts and burglary, at this stage targeting fuel and Deisel in and around Hikurangi and the main targets have been commercial vehicles.

So again, be vigilant, secure your property and keep an eye out on yours and your neighbour's property. If you see something suspicious, take some details of what you're seeing i.e., registration plates, description of person/s and give us a call or report to the 105 number so we can follow up.

Unlawful takes /Car Conversion

Vehicles thefts which have also been happening in the Whangarei Area as a whole. The car being targeted are mainly older Vehicles which don't have the computer chipped keys. Over the last number shave increased. A Holden Commodore Station Wagon was stolen stripped and burnt out on Otonga - Marua Road with the Gear box and engine missing, so if anyone has any information, please contact police. If you believe you own a sort for vehicle take the extra precaution and look into getting CCTV and possible vehicle trackers.

Drink Driving-

Just a reminder to plan your trips as winter sport is well into the season and we celebrate our wins please don't drink and drive. Police have got our traffic Alcohol Groups out and about with young keen staff wanting to make the street safe so, take care, look after each other and make the right decisions.

Our Traffic Alcohol groups have recently had some good result, resulting with high readings and vehicle impounds.

When you make the option to drink and drive you are putting everyone else in our community at risk, so please don't drink and drive.

And last of all I'd like to put in a plug for anyone that is interested in joining the NZ Police. Our Northland recruiter, Joe 'The Rock' TE AO is the man to speak to. He knows all you need to know about joining the Blue brothers and sisters. He can be contacted on Joseph.Teao@police.govt.nz (We are currently looking for numbers in the Far and Mid-north)

That's all from me this month. Kia tūpato - stay safe, take care, and look after each other. If there is an **Immediate** risk, call **111**. For non-urgent matters, contact Police on **105**, or speak directly with Rado or me. **Victim Support** is also available and offers confidential assistance.
